

- Always store paint in a cool, dry place. Extreme temperatures, such as freezing or above 120°F, can cause pigment settling and viscosity changes that may make paint unusable.
- For best results, opened paint containers should be used within 6 months. Unopened paint containers may be stored for up to 2 years. If opened at end of shelf life (2 years), paint should be used as quickly as possibly.
- To prevent cross contamination, which may cause paint to degrade and spoil, follow these steps:
  - Pour paint to be used into smaller, resealable containers.
  - Always use fresh water to clean brushes when working out of the smaller containers.
  - Do not pour used paint back into original container.
  - Do not dilute paint in the original container.
  - Do not dip brushes or other applicators into the original container.
- Close cap/lid tightly after every use.
