

- Store glazes in a cool, dry place. Avoid exposure to freezing.
 - If glazes do freeze, allow to thaw at room temperature.
- Tighten lids securely for storage. Exposure to air can allow the product to dry.
- · To prevent contamination:
 - Dispense glaze for use into smaller containers or onto a palette.
 - If pouring into smaller containers for use, wash the container thoroughly after each use.
 - Do not pour glaze back into original container after use.
 - Do not dip brushes or other applicators into original container.
- Use only distilled water if thinning a thick glaze.
- Store crystal glazes upside down (with lid on tight) as crystals will settle and can make stirring a challenge.
- To control the flow and minimize spills, remove cap and poke a hole through the inner seal rather than removing the entire seal.
- If pouring glaze into smaller containers, keep original bottle until smaller containers are consumed so that the lot code is available.
