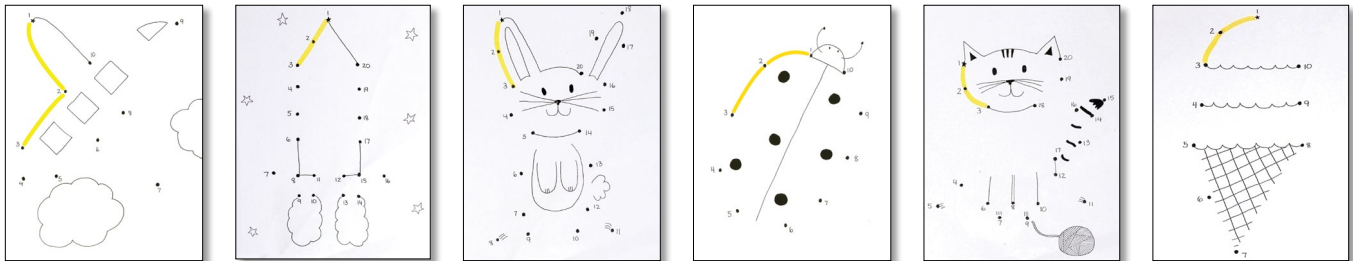


Hi-Write™ Dot-To-Dot

Introduction

Created by our own team working with early writers who have difficulty with traditional connect the dot activities, the Hi-Write Dot-to-Dot offers a successful way for children to begin working on tracing, and starting and stopping on a target in a more guided manner. Hi-Write Dot-to-Dot features a hi-lighted yellow line from numbers 1 to 3 and easy graphics, numbers and designs. Connect the dots activities are a wonderful tool for encouraging number recognition, pre-writing skills, crossing midline and visual tracking skills and the Hi-Write Dot-To-Dot is sure to keep your students asking for more!

Product Use

Hi-Write Dot-to-Dots can be used in one-on-one sessions, small group sessions, or in the classroom during prewriting and visualmotor activities. Here are a few ideas for getting started:

1. See if the child can identify the object in the picture before completing the connect-the-dots design.
2. Have the child use Wikki Stix, (not included) rolled out snakes of Play-Doh or Theraputty (not included) or yarn to follow the highlighted lines of the designs.
3. Have child use a different color to draw from one number to the next. This can help encourage a clear starting and stopping on each dot and support the concept of sequencing.
4. Let the child trace the shapes with their fingers first before tracing with a pencil. Make sure they are starting and stopping on the dots!
5. Tape a cut-out race car form to the top of the pencil and have the child 'drive' his car on the 'road' of each design.

Modifications

This paper may be used on a slantboard for improved visual orientation for the child and to encourage postural stability and appropriate pencil grasp during writing activities.

Wikki Stix: (item # 003343) reusable waxed thread that is great for molding and shaping

Theraputty: (assorted items and colors) wheat, gluten and casein free molding clay
