Introduction

Inspired by an older sister of young twins, the Draw on Me Table is a 25"L x 14.5"W table with a dry erase surface. Perfect for those "budding artists" who want to scribble, draw, and write on any surface, the Draw on Me Table makes it okay to mark on furniture! And the best part is: it's all erasable! So grab your dry erase markers (not included) and get to work.

Product Use

When opening the table, assemble the legs first. There are 3 different heights; for wheelchairs users and children sitting or standing. Adjust the height for the proper use. Some ideas:

- Encourage free hand drawing and/or theme work
- Practice design copying of shapes or letters
- Use cardboard or plastic stencils to encourage accuracy
- Use the Draw on Me Table as center in a classroom or in a bedroom or study for free time or homework.
- When erasing, have the child reach right hand to left side of table and vice versa to encourage midline crossing which helps with hand dominance and fine motor coordination.



Care & Safety

The Draw on Me Table measures 25"L x 14.5"W. $(63.5 \times 36.8 \text{ cm})$ The height adjusts from 15" to 22" $(38.1 \times 55.8 \text{cm})$. Use a dry eraser to clean surface after each use. Markings should be erased within a few hours of use. Wipe surface and PVC piping frame occasionally with a damp cloth. Recommended for ages 3 and up.
